This is a follow up to my letter dated March 19, 2009 regarding submission of a tunnel inspection report.

We have been made aware that you may be conducting or considering construction activities inside the space that is the subject of the above-referenced revocable consent. As you know, your revocable consent does not permit you to perform any work within the revocable consent space without the express written consent of DOT. DOT will not give consent to any such work unless it is being undertaken for the purpose of maintaining the integrity of the revocable consent space. Accordingly, this letter serves as an immediate demand to cease and desist any and all such unpermitted activities.
